Although gathering for the holidays this year may look a little different, we can cater your event. Individual meals set to suit your occasion!





What keeps us mentally, emotionally and physically motivated to do this work is our desire for stronger connections and tying our personal ideals into our farm days. Creating time in our work days and in our business life for conversations around emotional well-being while taking the time to talk about ways we can challenge patriarchy, homophobia, white supremacy, and other forms of oppression fulfills our passion to not just grow food, but to reimagine a new food system.
